- No items, from the either of the locked cabinets, may be handled away from staff monitoring. The items are locked in cabinets because they are irreplaceable.
- Staff will have to consistently monitor patrons' handling of archival and other materials. Please peruse items at the front desk (with gloves if item is archival).
- Xerox copies are permitted with staff supervision.
